Bobby Dale Brown went to be with his Lord and Savior on Wednesday, February 1, 2023 at the age of 66. The son of Omer Gene Brown and Ruby Jo (Newton) Brown, Bobby was born March 14, 1956 in Denton, TX. He attended Lewisville High School where he was a member of the Farmer Varsity Baseball team.

While working at Old Town Meat Market in Lewisville, Bobby learned the art of butchering from his boss and lifelong friend, Dickie Grant. Later he had a successful career as a car salesman, perfecting his skills under the mentorship of Paul Gibbons, working primarily for Reliable Chevrolet in Richardson, Crest Cadillac in Plano, and Autobahn in Ft. Worth. Bobby was a natural salesman and often his customers became longtime friends. Upon leaving the car sales industry, Bobby started his own business, Brown Roofing and Construction. Once again, due to the relationships he developed with them, many of his customers became friends.

In 1991 Bobby and Linda Segler were married. They primarily resided in Flower Mound, TX. They welcomed their beloved son, Tyler Gene Brown, in 1997. Bobby loved Tyler without measure and it was guaranteed he would

show Tyler's latest picture or tell a story about him at every available opportunity. Bobby and Linda divorced in 2012 but remained friends through the years.

In his younger years, Bobby had a great love for playing baseball. His family enjoyed spending time at the ballpark cheering for him. As an adult, he became an avid golfer and developed a great passion for bass fishing. He enjoyed watching golf, fishing shows, the Texas Rangers, and the Dallas Cowboys.

Bobby could start a conversation with anyone. He was a master storyteller and he always had a joke ready to go for any occasion. He had a smile that melted hearts and a laugh that was infectious.
