June 10, 1930 - January 19, 2023

Millie Jung of Denton, Texas passed away on January 19, 2023. Born June 10, 1930 in Taishan, China to parents Mar Him Kang Jung and Yip Kuen Kang Jung, she moved to Hong Kong and later immigrated to New Orleans as a teenager.

In the 1950s, Millie met Ronald Tan, a Singaporean studying at Louisiana State University. They married and moved to Singapore in 1958 to raise their children, Donna and Dennis. In 1976, the family immigrated to the United States and took up residence in Denver, Colorado. There, Millie trained as a nursing assistant and worked in that field for 20 years. She retired in 2004 and, soon after, moved to Denton, Texas, to be near her daughter's family.

In Denton, Millie had an active social life and many friends. She was a volunteer at Medical City Hospital where she was known as the Popcorn Lady. She was a member of the Searcher's Class at First United Methodist Church.

Millie is survived by her sisters and their spouses: Lily and Sherwood Hsieh of New York, Nancy and Tiong Su Tan of South Carolina, Mamie and George Kimata of Hawaii, and Rosie and Robert Hoy of Louisiana; her children and their spouses and partners: Donna and Jon Meinecke of Denton, Texas and Dennis Tan and Susan Yu of Los Angeles, California; her grandchildren and their spouses and partners: Colin Meinecke and Mackenzie Sheehy of Austin,
