



## Richard Winston MacGillivray

LEWISVILLE - Richard W. MacGillivray, 79, died on April 27, 2021, at Medical City Lewisville in Texas. He was born on April 29, 1941, in Owosso, Michigan, the son of Winston K. and Margaret Clark MacGillivray.

Richard graduated from Durand High School in Durand, Michigan. Following graduation, he served in the Navy as a medic.
