



Warren Allen Brown

January 21, 1943 - December 9, 2025

Warren “Bud” Brown passed away peacefully on December 9, 2025, surrounded by loved ones. He was 82 years old.

Buddy was born in Lowell Indiana to Lyle and Gwendolyn Brown on January 21, 1943. He graduated from Lowell High School and married his high school sweetheart Peggy Allen in 1962. They raised two children and owned businesses in town, Brown’s Wall and Covering, and then Red Wing Sports, until they moved to Dallas Texas in 1981.

He was active in the town of Lowell, including serving as the President of the Chamber of Commerce, Secretary of the Economic Development Commission, Commissioner for Boy Scouts of America, and he was also active in Kiwanis. Other fondly remembered contributions included hand carving totem poles for the two local Boy Scout troops, wearing stilts as the tall man during Oktoberfest, helping to train Lowell’s first police dogs (he was the bad guy) and anything else he could do to help his hometown.

After moving to Dallas at the age of 39 he worked as a flooring salesman until he retired. He was an avid fisherman and talented craftsman, building many beautiful pieces of furniture for family and friends. Bud could do anything he set his mind to and taught himself many things, including playing musical instruments, gardening, carving animals in gunstocks, and many other

creative endeavors.

He loved having poker night with his friends and co-workers, and he and Peggy went up to Winstar regularly to “get out of Dodge” as he called it. He was known for his sweet disposition and his goofy sense of humor, a great smile and a twinkle in his eye. He loved spending time with family and will be greatly missed.

Bud is survived by his loving wife Peggy Brown, daughter Lorri (Wally) Skaar, son Darin (Wenying) Brown, grandchildren Jessica Skaar, Alex Skaar, and Isaac Brown, sisters Sandra (Marv) Bredemeier, and Lisa (Brad) Buchanan, and numerous nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his parents Lyle and Gwendolyn Brown, and brothers Dean Brown and Terry Brown.
